Because of you, we are able to work with young girls who need support programs to make great choices and be less likely to become a target and victim of sexting, sex trafficking and abuse. She needs redemption and healing

We are also hard at work with police, agencies and communities to find the minor aged girls who have already been groomed, coerced and sold for sex all over our province (some as young as 12 years old). These are local girls, who in a moment make a bad choice and are shamed into something they cannot imagine. Trapped and unaware of how to get help, we reach them. One girl at a time, one horse at a time. The work is difficult, costly and emotional, but effective.

This is the sad truth of our work, but your donation in kind saved us dollars that are needed to reach even the most desperate girl with a message of hope and love. You have helped us not to worry about resources and instead be focused on our drive to meet her, guiding her to a safe place or even back home. She needs specialized care to overcome trauma and violent abuse. Your help also funds our support of police needing partners to speak to her, provide her with informed care and understanding.

The future of a girl who is found trapped in sex trafficking depends on our ability to be aware, care and share. Here are four ways you can choose from to help us keep her safe and cared for in these first months of 2019 if you are able:

Book an Aware, Care, Share Presentation for our agency to speak to your group, business, regional or national clubs, sectional provincial or national conferences association, (this presentation has been used by OPP, London Police Services and Ontario Police College for training and awareness and is tailored for Clubs, Non Profits, Groups and Businesses, Churches and Associations)
4. Volunteer to organize a fundraiser at your business to make a greater statement that #sheisnotforsale in your own group or community.
5. Learn about ProjectONroute and make history with us across our Province in 2019

Again, thank you for the kind gift and ongoing support! It encouraged the staff and volunteers that our community cares and is cheering us on. We know it is difficult to fathom that this is in our community and is a growing concern. But it is the truth and it needs our attention today. We hope that it gives you peace in knowing that your dollars enable us to focus and work to keep #eyesongirls. Farmtown is here for these girls and speaking up to support change in the systems of care and hope for futures, theirs and ours.
