
Provincial Report Barb Hore


Sheila has been our Club Focus Publisher since the Fall 2012 and has attracted many compliments from our neighbouring Clubs.

PEARL McCABE'S LEMON SQUARES AS GIVEN TO LINDA FORD OCTOBER 2016

To fit a 9 X 13 baking pan

Base:

1½ cup all-purpose flour ¾ cup butter 3 tbsp granulated sugar

Mix together. Spread in Pan. Bake 350° F for 10 minutes.

Filling:

1½ cup granulated sugar 1½ tsp all-purpose flour 3 eggs, lightly beaten 2¼ cups desiccated coconut ½ Lemon juice ½ Lemon grated rind

Mix together. Spread on the base. Bake 350° F for 20-25 minutes. Topping:
3/4 cup of butter
21/4 cups of icing sugar
6 oz. cream cheese
Small amount of lemon juice

Mix together. Spread on top when baked pan cools.


