atrizia Teresa Prez went by many names. Around our circle of friends she was Pat. Patricia, Patty P, Patsy Prez, and to some of us, Kramer, like Kramer from Seinfeld.

Patricia held her family as the most important thing in her life. She held many roles as wife, mother, daughter, caregiver, sister, sister-in-law, cousin, aunt, godmother, entrepreneur,

colleague, advocate, and to me, a dear friend. I met Patricia over 30 years ago at the Toronto Business and Professional Women's Club through a mutual BPW friend Dr. Doris Guyatt. At that time, Patricia was working for the provincial government and busy with wedding plans. After joining BPW, she was recruited into joining the board. While Patricia held several Executive positions on the board, including President, it was at the Advocacy and Resolutions Committee that we became fast friends. Over the years, we participated in numerous conferences and conventions. In 1996, Patricia was part of the BPW Canada's Young delegation team at the International Congress in Venice, Italy. Patricia was also a Canadian delegate at the UN Counsel on the Status of Women in NYC. She loved being with her BPW sisters locally, and around the world.

In between marrying the love of her life Bruno, raising two beautiful young men Andrew and Jason, running a household, working, volunteering, she found some time to have fun with "The Tribe."

Patricia's company lit up a room. She would always show up to a get together with something out of the ordinary. For example, at our game nights, she would bring a first aid kit knowing certain games were going to get out of control. At our BBQs and yoga retreats she would come decked out in a funny hat or outfit. She had a way of telling a story that would leave us in stitches. Besides the humour, she had a profound way of reminding us of how special our time was together. At an outdoor birthday event during the pandemic, she stopped everyone from talking and said, "take this all in, this moment, and

remember how special it is." Besides the crazy antics and profound moments at aet togethers. Patricia would call on the way to the grocery store to see if you needed anything. She was always checking in.

For me, she was a true friend. We were different in our approaches; we appreciated one another's point of view coming from love and truth. We would start the day by talking every morning between 6 and 6:30 am. This continued while she was in the hospital. We had very frank conversations on how we saw the world and debated many things. For example, when I was dating, she was very protective. Patricia always wanted to meet the guy I was dating, and always, always shared her opinions on what she thought of my choices. Sometimes she would say "What were you thinking?," "Are you kidding me?," "leave this one at the curb." Always the protective sister. Besides dating advice, she was a pillar of strength for me often providing much comic relief from life's crazy experiences. At the end of the day, we would connect again. I still laugh when I think of our conversations.

Patricia was kind. I learned from her, that kindness consists of loving people more than they deserve.

As much as she loved being with us, her heart remained with her family. She would get excited about family events. Patricia loved her hometown in Italy and loved spending time and laughing with her cousin Moreno and his family.

During our last conversation, she reflected on

the fun experiences we had with BPW and the get togethers with The Tribe.

She touched so many lives.

I'm going to miss you Patricia. You will always be in my heart.

You're not here Patricia Prez, but your presence lingers in the shadows.

You don't see what I see, but I hear you laughing with me when I laugh.

You don't know what I feel, but I feel you, feeling with me. Rest in peace my

friend.

BPW Canada AGM

Nearly 40 BPW Canada members from across the country attended the 2023 online Annual General Meeting on Saturday, August 12, 2023. There were 23 Club Delegates plus 8 Board Officers debating 8 resolutions, 2 commendations, and financials.

Mina Di Domenico was the BPW Brampton delegate for this virtual meeting and had two votes on behalf of Brampton members. The event attendees also received updates on key priorities for the term: Reproductive Rights and Justice, Anti-Human Sex Trafficking, and IDEAS programming.

The following resolutions were discussed, debated, and voted on and carried:

- Support to Add Non-State Torture to the Criminal Code of Canada submitted by North Toronto and seconded by BPW Brampton.
- Women's Access to Health Services and Health Education through Technology submitted by BPW Brampton and seconded by BPW London.
- National Early Learning and Child Care (ELCC)
 Standards for Inclusion, Diversity, Equity and Access
 submitted by BPW London and seconded by BPW
 Bowmanville.
- Improving the Reproductive Health Services
 Process Across Canada moved by BPW London
 and seconded by BPW Moncton.
- Supporting Access to Abortion and Other Reproductive Services Across Canada moved by BPW London and seconded by BPW Moncton.
- Updated Health Related Risks and Consequences of Alcohol Use and Abuse in Women submitted by BPW Selkirk and seconded by BPW London.
- Supporting Education for Girls and Women in Afghanistan submitted by BPW Online Club and seconded by BPW Brampton.
- Workplace Harassment in the Royal Canadian Mounted Police moved and seconded by BPW Edmonton club delegates.

Commendations for Lisa LaFlamme from BPW
Hastings and Prince Edward County and Senator Julie
Miville-Dechêne from BPW Montreal were accepted.
Mina Di Domenico is a member of the Reproductive
Rights and Justice Committee and the BPW Canada
Advocacy and Resolution Committee.
